

Regulations of the Statistical Society of Australia, Victorian Branch

The Constitution of the Branch allows for Regulations, under Clause 15 (d). Regulations can be made, amended or repealed by Council. Any Regulation made by Council shall be confirmed, amended or annulled at the next Annual General Meeting.

At the meeting of the Council of the Victorian Branch on 10 March 2010 a motion to repeal all existing Regulations was carried unanimously. This motion was endorsed at the Annual General Meeting of the Branch on 30 March 2010.

At the meeting of the Council of the Victorian Branch on 10 March 2010 a motion to create the following Regulation was carried unanimously.

Regulation

Notices and communications shall be sent to members by email where available, or by post otherwise, using the email address or postal address supplied by each member. It is each member's responsibility to inform the Branch Secretary of any change of address.

At the Annual General Meeting of the Branch on 30 March 2010 this Regulation was confirmed. From 30 March 2010, until Council takes further action in relation to Regulations, the Branch therefore has one Regulation, as listed above.
